NON-COMPLIANT CPC & CTS CERTIFICANTS!

On May 18, 2011, The National Association of Personnel Services (NAPS), in accordance with recommendations from the Certification Committee, approved an Amnesty Program for recruiters who have allowed their CPC or CTS credential to expire. This program allows for reinstatement of expired credentials according to an established policy. This is a one-time opportunity.

Please review the Amnesty Program policy below. Our standard CEU log is available for download on our web site. We recommend that you begin the process as soon as possible as this is a limited **time program that will expire on December 31, 2011.**

AMNESTY PROGRAM POLICY

This program has been developed for those recruiters who have allowed their CPC or CTS credential to expire.

The following requirements must be met for reinstatement of expired credentials:

- Must have passed either the CPC or CTS exam after January 1, 1995
- Must complete the necessary hours for 1 year of CEU (17 hours of educational materials) and document them using the NAPS CEU log ([CLICK HERE](#) to access the form).
- Include the \$27.00 annual administrative fee as outlined in the CEU LOG.
- Must send the form with payment in to NAPS HQ per the instructions on the form **postmarked on or before December 31, 2011.**

The Amnesty Program is a one-time limited opportunity.
